## 2021 GRIFFIN AREA ARTS ALLIANCE SCHOLARSHIP

Deadline for submission: Thursday, May 6, 2021

Purpose: To award a \$500 scholarship to a graduating senior who has contributed to the arts in the community and intends to continue his/her participation or study in an area of artistic expression.

### GUIDELINES AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION:

- 1. Applicant must currently be a senior in good standing at Griffin, Spalding, or Pike High School who has been accepted at an institution of higher learning. Proof of enrollment will be required to receive scholarship funds.
- 2. Applicant must have participated in community arts activities sponsored by a GAAA member organization or his/her high school within the past 12 months. Current GAAA members are Camelot Theatre Company, Griffin Area Concert Association, Griffin Choral Arts, Griffin Ballet Theatre, Griffin-Spalding Art Association, and Main Street Players.
- 3. Applicant must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.5 with minimum grades of 3.0 in courses of artistic expression. An official transcript must accompany the application.
- 4. Application must include 2 recommendation letters (core academic teacher and GAAA member organization/HS arts teacher or club advisor ). Letters must be on the attached forms and submitted with the application in separate sealed envelopes.
- 5. Completed applications with all supporting documents must be hand delivered by 5:00 pm May 6 to the Griffin-Spalding Chamber of Commerce at 143 N. Hill Street, Griffin.
- 6. Scholarship winner(s) will be notified by Monday, May 24. Check(s) will be awarded at the Griffin Area Arts Alliance Heart for the Arts presentation during the Griffin June Jam on Saturday, June 12.
